

# Supply List for Plein Air Workshop

The supplies needed to paint out of doors do not need to be complicated or extensive. Be sure to dress appropriately for the weather and terrain (covered feet, hat, rain poncho or similar).

Bring Snacks/lunch, drinking water, bug spray, sun screen.

The list below is a suggestion of what to bring. Feel free to bring your own preferred supplies.

## For Painting: Basic List

- Easel if you have one,
- Folding stool or chair- if you wish to bring one
- Small sketchbook-postcard size, sketchbook-same size as painting, 2B pencil, kneaded eraser, black marker or black wash or other preferred drawing media
- Transfer paper
- Watercolor Block –Size 7x10”to 10x14” Arches cold, rough or hot press. 140lb.or 11”x14” paper attached to board and taped
- Palette with 2 yellows (Aureolin or Lemon Yellow), 2 reds (Cadmium & Permanent Alizarin), 2 blues (Cobalt & Ultramarine), other colors you may have - Artist grade recommended
- Water container and water
- Brushes should include: One large flat brush, one smaller flat (1”), one Round Brush #8 is usually good, Rigger and any other preferred brushes
- Soft Rag and /or Paper towel.
- Camera or iPhone
