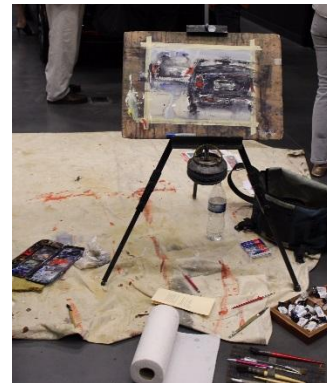
Publicity
